In an effort to promote Summer Reading this year we will host an art contest with the youth of Fountain Hills.

- Bookmark must use the space theme “Imagine Your Story!” and include a brief message and/or picture that supports this theme. Images should be large enough to be easily seen and understood. Bookmarks will be judged on originality, artwork, and message delivery.
- By submitting artwork, the artist grants Maricopa County Library District the permission to reproduce and display his/her artwork for use in the Fountain Hills Branch Library’s Summer Reading Program 2020. Entries will not be returned.
